Science20 Dialogue Forum Improving Global Health: Strategies and Tools to Combat Communicable and Non-Communicable Diseases

The annual summit of the heads of state and government of the Group of Twenty (G20), comprising major industrialised and emerging economies, will be held in Hamburg on 7-8 July 2017 under German presidency. In addition to issues related to global economic growth and financial market regulation, health will also be an important focus of the G20 Summit.

During the G20 Presidency, Chancellor Dr. Angela Merkel will be conducting a wide-ranging dialogue with civil society. For the first time, the science and research community is included into this dialogue as "Science20". Under the leadership of the German National Academy of Sciences Leopoldina, the science academies of the G20 countries have elaborated science-based recommendations on improving global health.

At the Science20 Dialogue Forum on 22 March 2017 in Halle (Saale), strategies and tools to combat communicable and non-communicable diseases will be discussed by national and international experts. Moreover, the Science20 Statement will be officially handed over to Federal Chancellor Dr. Angela Merkel.

Simultaneous translation in English and German will be provided.

Founded in 1652, the Leopoldina brings together some 1,500 outstanding scientists from about 30 countries. It is dedicated to the advancement of science for the benefit of humankind and to shaping a better future. In its role as the German National Academy of Sciences, the Leopoldina represents the German scientific community in international committees. It offers unbiased scientific opinions on political and societal questions, publishing independent studies of national and international significance. The Leopoldina promotes scientific and public debate, supports young scientists, confers awards for scientific achievements, conducts research projects, and campaigns for the human rights of persecuted scientists.
